

Course	Pain Management (PM) Certificate
General	The Pain Management Certificate (PMC) course provides an opportunity for members who hold current First Aid and Advanced Resuscitation Techniques qualifications to be able to contribute to patrols. The ability and confidence to administer pain relieving medication to a patient, in an emergency situation, whilst complying with legislative and organisational requirements is a key support role to the Patrol, while being another way that appropriately qualified members can contribute to the club and the community it serves.
Prerequisites	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Currently financial club member • Minimum age 18 years • Currently proficient in First Aid (HLTAID011) and Advanced Resuscitation Techniques (either ART or HLTAID015) <p>NOTE 1: The First Aid qualification should have at least one year of currency from 31/12/2022. All ART qualifications require annual skills maintenance</p> <p>NOTE 2: Proof of currency in First Aid and ART is required before you can join the course – see in Questions section, below</p>
