Course	IRB Driver Course – July 2024
General	The Silver Medallion IRB Driver (IRBD) course is the second level of powercraft training in surf lifesaving. The IRBD is a key role in the patrol team. The aim of this course is to provide participants with the skills and knowledge to effectively drive and manage an Inflatable Rescue Boat (IRB) in surf rescue operations
Date starting	Wednesday, 3 July 2024
Prerequisites	 minimum of 16 years of age to commence training minimum of 17 years of age on the date of final assessment hold and be proficient in the SLSA awards: - Bronze Medallion - IRB Crew Certificate Hold a WA Recreational Skippers Ticket – this can be achieved by the candidate during the course but must be completed by time of assessment. Note: Candidates can claim the cost of the Skippers Ticket fee through the Club.
